



Wellcare by Ohana Health Plan Musculoskeletal Management Program Provider Education Webinars

In keeping with our commitment of promoting continuous quality improvement for services provided to Wellcare by Ohana Health Plan Medicare Advantage Primary Members, effective **April 1, 2024**, Wellcare by Ohana Health Plan has entered into an agreement with Evolent (formerly National Imaging Associates, Inc. (NIA)), to implement a Musculoskeletal (MSK) Management Program. This program includes prior authorization for **non-emergent MSK procedures including: inpatient and outpatient hip, knee, shoulder, lumbar, and cervical spine surgeries for the non-IPA Wellcare by Ohana Health Plan Medicare Advantage Primary Members. This decision is consistent with industry-wide efforts to ensure clinically appropriate quality of care and to manage the increasing utilization of these services.**

For Ohana QUEST Integration Primary, please continue to follow the existing process and submit the Prior Authorizations directly to Ohana Health Plan. For HI Senior Medical Group IPA Members, please continue to follow the existing process and submit the Prior Authorizations directly to Advanced Medical Management.
